**Payment for the box kit lumber amount only** should be made to MWDI at \$21.65 per kit (includes tax).

**If you have not ordered kits and wish assembly, you may send both checks to MWDI and we will get them to Aaron.**

Please also email your kit orders and assembly needs as soon as possible so that we can plan our volunteer cut day / distribution logistics effectively. If we do not hear from you about assembly, MWDI will assume you want kits only and you must pick them up in Annapolis late afternoon May 5th thru May 7th or make other arrangements.

**Alternative Option:** 10 board feet can be provided if a kit is not desired.

MWDI aggregates these orders with its public lands program to provide wholesale pricing to private program sponsors. MWDI volunteers pick up the lumber and cut it into kits for free. The kit cost is based on MWDI's direct lumber expense. MWDI makes no profit.

Box kits are approximately 23" tall and 10" wide. Lumber is rough cut, one side, tight knot, cedar. Kits should be assembled relatively soon as the wood is not kiln dried and some splitting may occur if stored for a prolonged period in dry conditions.
